<u>Election News</u> — At 5 p.m. on Tuesday, December 27, 2022, the filing period for the April 4, 2023 Municipal Election officially closed.

During the filing period, seven candidates filed for a four-year term as either Mayor or an Aldermen.

Those candidates are:

For Mayor — Mike Zaring (unopposed)

For Ward 1 — Dave Doerhoff or Kile Chaney

For Ward 2 — Marcia Milner or Joshua Coffey

For Ward 3 — William 'Bill' Mills (unopposed)

For Ward 4 — Gary Davidson (unopposed)

The election will be held Tuesday, April 4. The voter registration deadline for this election is March 8, 2023. By registering, you have the opportunity to have your voice heard and decide who serves in the offices of leadership here in Harrisonville.

<u>Sign Up for Autopay Today!</u> — Looking for an easier way to pay your utility bill?

Autopay could be your answer! Autopay saves time, money, and worry when paying your utility bill. With Autopay, your bill is paid automatically from your checking account on the 15th of each month, with no processing fees or additional deductions. Autopay users still receive a monthly statement from the City that will tell you the amount of your utility bill. But you do nothing! The bill will be paid automatically from your account, as long as there are enough funds available for withdrawal.



To sign up for Autopay, speak with our Utility staff at City Hall or download an authorization form in the Utility Information section at www.harrisonville.com

As a reminder, utility bills are due on the first day of each month and must be paid by 5 p.m. on the 15th of the month to avoid a 10-percent penalty.

<u>Utility Deadlines</u> — We would like to make residents aware of the final deadlines for payment of past due January and February utility accounts.

January......Wednesday, Jan. 25, before 5 p.m. FebruarySaturday, Feb. 25, before 5 p.m.

After the deadline — Past due accounts will be charged a \$50 administrative fee, applicable additional fees and scheduled for disconnection. If you have questions about the utility-payment policy, please call City Hall at (816) 380-8900.
