Inclement Weather Policy

Policy Statement:

The inclement weather policy for the Harrisonville Community Center is designed to prioritize the well-being and safety of staff, participants, and visitors. The Community Center will close or adjust services based on the following information:

- **School Cancellations**: The Harrisonville School District canceling school due to inclement weather
- **Weather Advisories/Warnings**: Weather warnings or advisories from the weather service, including snow accumulation, freezing rain, or high winds
- **Consultation with Local Authorities**: The City of Harrisonville Streets Department and the Missouri Department of Transportation (MODoT) evaluation of road conditions and weather safety
- **City Facility Closures**: If City government offices are closed due to inclement weather, the Community Center will also be closed to align with the City's weather related closures.

Sports Practices or Games:

When the Harrisonville School District cancels school due to inclement weather, all Harrisonville Parks and Recreation sports practices and games will be cancelled.

Kids Connect and Day Camps

When the Harrisonville School District cancels school due to inclement weather, all Harrisonville Parks and Recreation Kids Connect and Day Camp programs will be cancelled.

Conclusion:

The inclement weather policy for the Harrisonville Community Center underscores our commitment to the safety and well-being of all stakeholders. If there is a closure or adjustment to services, the Community Center will communicate as soon as the decision is made through Rainout Line notifications, social media channels, and the Community Center website.
