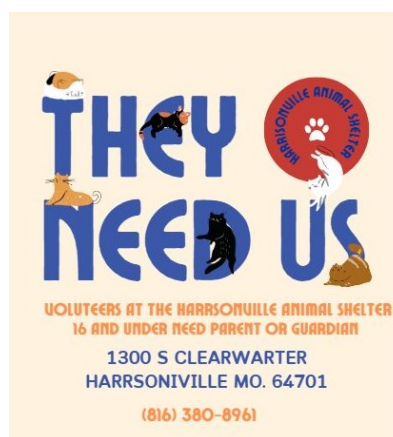

Volunteer duties include walking/playing with dogs, playing with cats, cleaning dog and cat kennels, laundry/dishes/sweeping/mopping, bathing, taking pictures, obedience training and cleaning the turf area.
