THANK YOU CITIZENS OF HARRISONVILLE

On Tuesday, April 4th, 2017 the Citizens of Harrisonville approved the extension of a ¼ cent sales tax for Harrisonville Parks & Recreation operations with an overwhelming 77%. This will create a full ½ cent designated sales tax for the Parks & Recreation Department after the Community Center debt is paid off in 2022. Below is the ballot question as a recap for your information:

SALES TAX RENEWAL QUESTION APRIL 4, 2017 BALLOT LANGUAGE

Shall the City of Harrisonville, Missouri be authorized to continue to impose a sales tax at a rate of one-quarter percent, currently scheduled to expire at the end of 2022, for the purpose of providing funds for the operation, maintenance, improvement, and expansion of Parks & Recreation amenities and services? This measure does not increase the existing sales tax.

WHAT'S NEXT?

The Harrisonville Parks & Recreation Department and the Park Board will begin working on a 10 year plan for improving existing facilities and future Parks and Recreation development. We will review the current Master Plan and along with citizen input develop future designs of new amenities.
