**November Town Hall meeting** — At 9 a.m. on November 2, Mayor Judy Bowman, Alderwoman Judith Reece and Alderman Dave Doerhoff will host a Town Hall Meeting in the HUB at the Harrisonville United Methodist Church, located at 2600 E Mechanic Street. The meeting's guest presenter will be Harrisonville Parks & Rec Director Chris Deal. Deal will share about Department's project to bring a dog park to Harrisonville! Several in the community voiced the need for a dog park and now it's happening! Come and



learn about the location, timeline, fundraising opportunities and how you can get involved in the Dog Park Project! During the event, you will also be able to hear the latest from City Hall and be able to speak with your elected officials. The event is open to all Harrisonville residents! Refreshments will be served.

**Dispose of Autumn Leaves Properly** — As the autumn leaves start to fall, please remember that the quick, simple, easy way to dispose of fallen leaves is to place them in biodegradable paper bags, marked "Yard Waste" or put them, unbagged, in a can, separate from the household trash. Place the bags or cans on the opposite side of the driveway from regular trash containers. The

leaves will be collected on the same day as the other trash, although, not necessarily by the



same truck. Please do not rake, sweep or blow leaves into the streets. Leaves in the street end up in our storm sewers, clogging the lines and causing backups and flooding when it rains. Through a recent change to City Ordinances, burning leaves and other small yard waste will be allowed only during the months of October, November and December.

**Fall Brush Drop-Off** — The City of Harrisonville will hold its 2019 Fall Brush Drop-Off event on Friday, October 25 and Saturday, October 26, rain or shine. This drop off will be from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. both days, with gates closing promptly at 5. To access the drop off site, please follow the directional signs from the pool in the City Park at Bradley Avenue and Ash Street. Crews will be available to help unload trailers. City personnel ask that all limbs be less than 10" in diameter. No yard waste, please. **The drop off is available only to those who live within the City limits. Residents should be prepared to show proof of residency, such as a utility bill, to take advantage of the drop off.** Contractors will not be allowed to use the service. Mulch and compost will be available for residents. The City will provide the equipment for loading all outgoing materials.

**For residents affected by recent flooding** – Residents whose homes suffered damage during the flash flood event on September 28, are asked to please report it to the City. Residents are asked to call (816) 380-8900 to report their damage. We would also like to inform residents that the Board of Aldermen, in an effort to not cause any unnecessary hardship for property owners, has passed a resolution to waive building permit fees for structures damaged by the flood. This new resolution will also apply to structures damaged in any future natural disasters or severe weather events. NOTE: Residents will still be required to apply for building permits, when making repairs.

**Holiday Closings** – City Hall will be closed on Monday, Nov. 11 for Veterans Day and on Nov. 28 and 29 for Thanksgiving. The Community Center will be open normal hours on Nov. 11, closed on Thanksgiving, and open from 7 a.m. to 3 p.m. on Nov. 29.

**Utility Deadlines** – The City of Harrisonville would like to make residents aware of the final deadlines for payment of past due October and November accounts.  
October .....Friday, Oct. 25, before 5 p.m.  
November.....Monday, Nov. 25, before 5 p.m.
